VANDERLIP'S PLAN SCORED BY WALL STREET TO DELAY ALL CURRENCY LEGISLATION.

As a final gambit to arms, to beat back the rising sentiment in favor of the central bank scheme as proposed recently by Frank A. Vanderlip of the National City Bank of New York city, Representative Carriger Glass, chairman of the House Banking and Currency committee, issued a statement last night in which he called the Vanderlip plan everything he could think of from a red herring to an incoherent jumble of Aldrich plan patterns.

What He Thought in July. "If such a board as is proposed were formed by appointing the seven leading bankers of the United States—whenever they may be—and these men became dissociated from the daily conduct of actual affairs, and sat in Washington, directing at arm's length the operations of the seven reserve banks, they would very rapidly lose the power to direct wisely."

Opposed Uniform Rate. "In one way the system of regional reserve banks has an advantage over the National Reserve Association proposed by the national monetary commission. The plan for a National Reserve Association provided that there should be a uniform rate of discount throughout the United States. The present plan for regional reserve banks contemplates the rate of discount will vary in different sections of the country at the same time."

Embodied in His Plan. "Now Mr. Vanderlip comes with a central bank plan embodying every one of the most objectionable features. If national banks will leave the system under the House bill how can they be expected to remain in under Mr. Vanderlip's plan of 'compulsion' and 'consolidation' and 'judicial control'?"

Cites Inconsistencies. "So I might continue indefinitely to point out the inconsistencies between Mr. Vanderlip's letter to me last July and his proposals before the Senate Banking committee in October. The conclusion that I reach from this whole controversy is that this Vanderlip plan, as prepared, as I am told, by Mr. Vanderlip of the National City Bank in conjunction with Mr. Davison of J. P. Morgan & Co. and Mr. Strong, with the Standard Oil connection, is intended to confuse the question of banking and currency reform; or else it is hoped that by the adoption of such a plan some of the ablest centralization it will be far easier hereafter for certain gentlemen to get control of the money market."

In accordance with its custom at the close of its biennial sessions, the Supreme Council of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, with Sovereign Grand Commander James D. Richardson presiding, yesterday morning held memorial services for the late Gen. Albert Pike, who was for thirty-one years its sovereign grand commander, and who is credited with having conceived and originated the rite which it was at its lowest ebb.
